

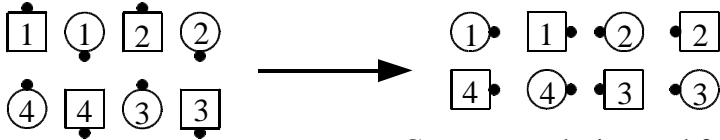

<anyone> <cross> Kickoff

Welcome to Keith's Class. This month we will look at <anyone> <cross> Kickoff. The “<anyone>” designates someone for one action in the call. This can lead to some interesting results..

DEFINITION: Designated dancers Run (or Cross Run) and Roll. Others Partner Tag.

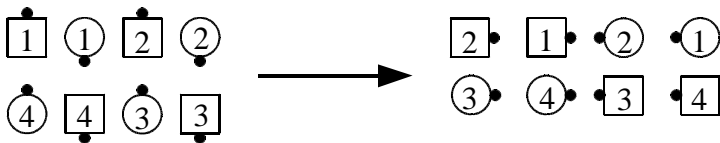
Centers Kickoff



Centers are designated for the Run and Roll. Ends Partner Tag into adjacent center spot.

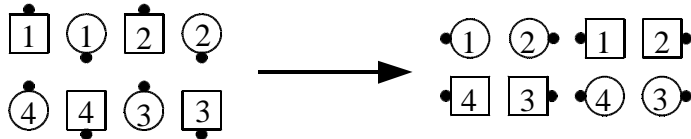
This is a very common usage of this call. But it can get trickier!

Centers Cross Kickoff



Centers are designated for the Cross Run and Roll. Ends Partner Tag into adjacent center spot. Ends don't do anything “Cross”.

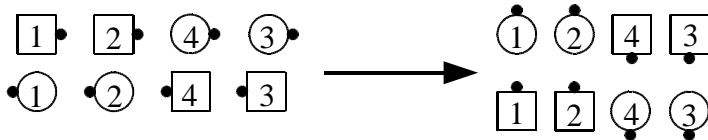
Ends Cross Kickoff



Ends are designated for the Cross Run and Roll. Centers Partner Tag into adjacent end spot.

This is not nearly as common as Centers Kickoff. The Centers are tempted to try to do something “Cross” and go the wrong way!

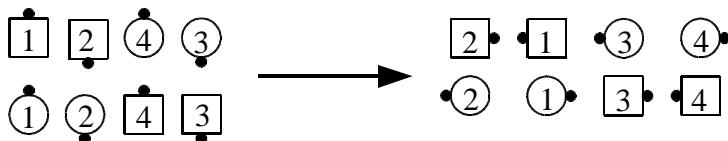
Boys Kickoff



“Boys” are designated.

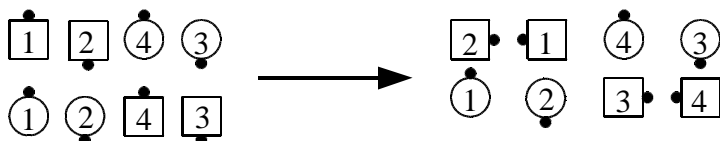
This is easy.

Boys Kickoff



“Boys” are designated. But Girls still have to do their Partner Tag.

Boys Boys Kickoff



Girls do nothing..

What do you mean, “Boys Boys”? The first “Boys” is NOT the designator for who does the Run and Roll. It tells us that only the “Boys” do the call. The second “Boys” is the designator.
